

Call for trans and non-binary folks living in Toronto to join ACT's Community Engagement Committee.

ACT is committed to supporting communities affected by HIV in Toronto, including trans and non-binary folks. By forming committees, organizing consultation, and engaging with community stakeholders, we work with individuals and communities and empower them to take an active role in determining, planning and directing their health, care, and well-being.

Community Engagement Committee Member - Role description:

Community Engagement Committee members will help inform the development and implementation of new community interventions and learning resources to strengthen the capacity of healthcare providers and social service workers who provide care to trans and non-binary folks in Toronto.

Duties:

- Attend three committee meetings scheduled in the evenings between July 2022 and March 2023. These meetings will take place at ACT's office (543 Yonge Street).
- Help inform the development of ACT's community consultation for trans and non-binary folks living in Toronto, investigating the health and healthcare needs among these communities.
- Help promote the community consultation and recruit informants.
- Help inform the development and implementation of new community interventions and knowledge mobilization products for healthcare providers and social service workers who provide care to trans and non-binary folks.

Compensation:

- \$50 honorarium for each meeting (\$150 total)
- TTC tokens and grocery gift cards

Selection:

10 trans and non-binary folks living in Toronto will be selected to participate. We welcome community members of diverse ages, cultures, abilities, races, religions, sexual orientations, and socio-economic locations to apply. We especially encourage community members who are Black, Indigenous, or People of Colour, living with HIV, involved in sex work, and/or use substances to apply.
